Preliminary matters regarding standing

1. The Alberta Utilities Commission issued a notice of application for Proceeding 29273. Two groups, the Medicine Hat Utilities Ratepayer Association (MHURA) and the Medicine Hat Land Developers Group (MHL D Group), submitted statements of intent to participate (SIPs) in the proceeding. Before issuing its standing ruling, the Commission wishes to hear from the parties regarding some preliminary matters.

Location of interveners

2. The AUC requires interveners to demonstrate that they have legal rights that may be directly and adversely affected by the AUC’s decision on the application. Neither MHURA nor the MHL D Group provided the location of the land to which their members have a legal right. The Commission requests that both groups, MHL D Group in particular, submit this information in the form of a legal land location description or municipal address, by **December 4, 2024**.

City of Medicine Hat comments on statements of intent to participate

3. The AUC wishes to receive submissions from the City of Medicine Hat regarding the SIPs filed by MHURA and the MHL D Group. The City may file its comments by **December 6, 2024**.

4. MHURA and the MHL D Group may submit reply comments by **December 10, 2024**.
